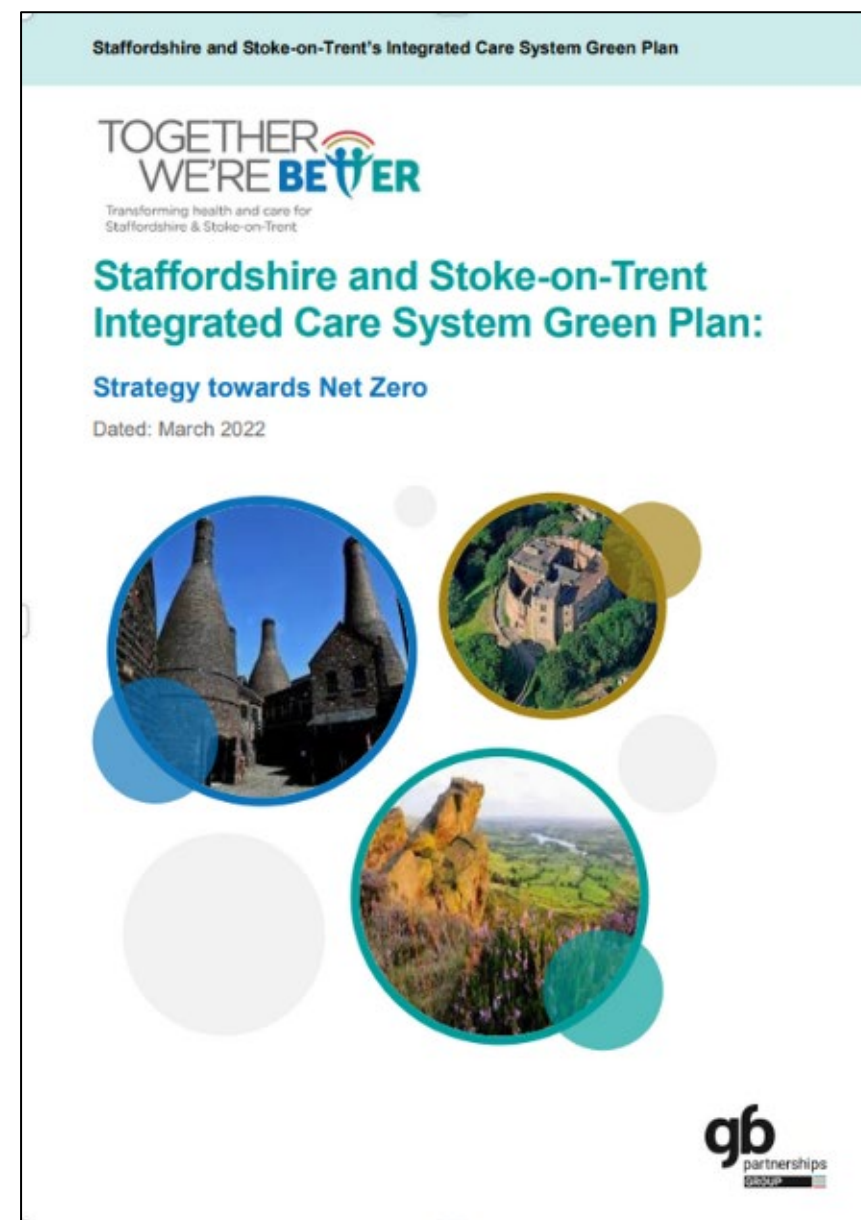

There was also a close working relationship with the ICS comms and marketing team to ensure it followed the locally recognised practices.
